

Terms of acceptance non-recyclable waste



Permitted:

- ✓ Residue after sorting of materials required to be kept separate at the source (must not include recyclables (!) paper & cardboard, metals, wood)
- ✓ Only in roller containers: comparable in nature and dimensions (max. 1m x 1m x 0.5m) with household sortable waste



The above summary of permitted waste flows and their origins is exhaustive.

NOT permitted:

- × Recyclable flows, especially those that must be presented selectively in accordance with local legislation:
 - Flanders: Decree of the Flemish Government concerning the sustainable management of material cycles and waste substances dd. 17/02/20112 (VLAREMA), incl. all amendments.
 - Wallonia: Decree of the Walloon Government concerning the mandatory selective collection of certain waste substances dd. 05/03/2015, incl. all amendments.
 - Brussels: Decree of the Government of the Brussels Capital Region concerning the management of waste substances dd. 01/12/2016, incl. all amendments.
- × Hazardous goods and/or substances such as fireworks, pressurised containers, electrical and electronic devices.
- × Solid items that may cause damage to machines (shredders, transport tyres, ...)
- × Liquids and dusty products
- × Strings, ribbons, ropes, rolled up or otherwise, with a total length of > 4 m. Materials with a total length of < 4 m must be easily shreddable.
