

## Terms of acceptance stone rubble

HMRP Rubble, rubble from concrete, bricks or other stone-like material.

### **Permitted:**

Stone-like material such as cobbles, concrete, natural stone, ceramic material, masonry and limestone sand.

### **Not permitted:**

- × Plaster/aerated concrete (minimum permitted)
- × Soil (minimum permitted)
- × Rust rubble
- × Insulation material
- × Industrial waste
- × Suspected asbestos materials
- × Hazardous waste
- × Chemicals
- × Chimney waste, soot residue (incl. slag and ash)
- × Sand-lime brick
- × Tar-containing asphalt rubble
- × Asphalt
- × Bituminous roof covering and roof gravel
- × Solid ceramic material
- × Non-hardened cement or concrete
- × Railway ballast
- × Screened sand
- × Rubble from soil materials, fire, sanitation, mandatory drainage or landfill mining
- × Other waste substances such as household waste, plastics, paper, vegetable waste, wood, etc.
